



You are receiving this because your club is currently entered in an event at Orlando Sports Center (OSC). We would like to provide all players, coaches, and directors with some important facility information in advance, to prevent any issues when you arrive at the venue. As coaches and directors we ask that you remind your players and parents and also lead by example with these rules.

Any yellow curb on Orlando Sports Center property is a designated Fire Lane. Parking next to the curb or on the curb will result in a citation. If you are parking on Kingspointe (the road located directly outside the facility) please be sure to park in the same direction of traffic or else it could result in a citation. There will also be no parking sides on one side of the street please do not park where these signs are placed. Be aware of the law as it pertains to parking next to a stop sign or fire hydrant. On OSC's property there are no parking signs located on the grass areas, violators of this rule are subject to being towed. As part of a fundraiser for Orlando Volleyball Academy's scholarship program we have been auctioning off parking spots. These spots will be marked with the necessary signage, violators will be towed. We wanted to provide everyone with this information in an effort to reduce the amount of citations while at our events.

Food is not allowed in the gym areas at all. The only drinks allowed in the gym are bottles with caps on them. Fountain drinks or coffee will not be permitted inside the gym. The restaurant will be open for every event and will have a wide selection of items for players, family and friends. Coolers are not allowed in the facility or around the building on the walkways. If you bring a cooler please leave it in your vehicle as we need to maintain clear walkways around the building for emergency access. As always, Tailgating out of your vehicle is welcome and encouraged. We ask that everyone is respectful of the facility and help pick up after yourself. We ask that coaches' lead by example, when your team is done playing, please have your team pick up their water bottles around the bench area. Everyone's help with this is greatly appreciated as we try very hard to keep the facility clean for spectators.

OSC will be charging an admission fee to enter events held at the facility. The admission fee for most events is \$5 with children under 9 admitted free of charge. The fee is good for the entire day.

We are striving to make the OSC the premiere sports complex in the southeast and welcome any comments on what can be done to improve your experience.
